At CSBA, his research addresses two broad questions. First, how should the United States adapt its military strategy, capabilities, posture, and alliance relationships in response to changes in the balance of power as well as trends in future warfare? Second, how should we think about the role of nuclear weapons, including the size and shape of the U.S. arsenal as well as the impact of proliferation on regional security competitions? His current academic work focuses on how established powers respond to emerging powers and the relationship between grand strategy and military strategy.

Dr. Montgomery is the author of numerous CSBA reports and policy briefs, most recently *The Future of America's Strategic Nuclear Deterrent*. He has also published articles in *Foreign Affairs*, *International Security*, *Security Studies*, and *The Journal of Strategic Studies*, and his commentary has appeared in *Defense News*, *The Diplomat*, *The National Interest*, and *Real Clear Defense*.

He graduated summa cum laude from Villanova University with a B.A. in Political Science and Sociology, and received his M.A. and Ph.D. in Foreign Affairs from the University of Virginia. He is a member of the International Institute for Strategic Studies.
