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Scott Kennedy is deputy director of the Freeman Chair in China Studies and director of the Project on Chinese Business and Political Economy at CSIS. A leading authority on China's economic policy and its global economic relations, his research examines Chinese industrial policy, business lobbying, multinational business challenges in China, Chinese participation in global economic regimes, and philanthropy.

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Kennedy was a professor at Indiana University (IU) for over 14 years. From 2007 to 2014, he was director of the IU Research Center for Chinese Politics & Business, and he was founding academic director of the IU China Office. From 1993 to 1997, he worked at the Brookings Institution.

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
