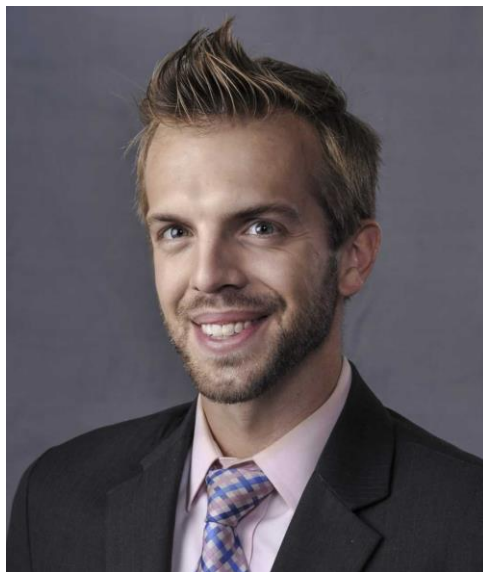


Adam Lysenko
