Johannes Petry is a IRC Postdoctoral Fellow at the SCRIPTS Cluster of Excellence in Berlin and a Research Fellow at the Centre for the Study of Globalization and Regionalization, University of Warwick. He holds a PhD in International Political Economy from the Department of Politics and International Studies at the University of Warwick. His research focuses on the differential development and organization of capital markets as well as the role financial infrastructures such as exchanges, index providers or clearing houses play in global finance. Thereby, he compares the organization and development of capital markets in China with 'global' capital markets as well as on the gradual integration of Chinese markets into global finance and their increasing internationalization. He is a co-founder of the Warwick Critical Finance Group, a Management Committee member of the China in Europe COST-Action Research Network and the Principal Investigator (PI) of the DFG-funded StateCapFinance-research project which comparatively analyses capital markets in six emerging economies. His research has been published in *Review of International Political Economy*, *Economy & Society*, *New Political Economy* and *Competition & Change*.
