Executive Director, Wisconsin Project on Nuclear Arms Control



Ms. Valerie Lincy has served as the Executive Director of the Wisconsin Project on Nuclear Arms Control since 2012. She leads the organization's research on weapons of mass destruction supply networks, which is used by governments to support sanctions and counterproliferation actions. She is Editor of Iran Watch, a website she created in 2003 to track and analyze Iran's nuclear and missile programs and international efforts to counter these programs. She also oversees the Wisconsin Project's Risk Report, a comprehensive database of entities suspected of involvement in WMD proliferation. She leads outreach efforts in some 40 countries to support effective strategic trade controls, including through use of the Risk Report.

Prior to joining the Wisconsin Project, Valerie worked as a researcher in several Washington D.C. think tanks and at the *New York Times* and *Newsweek* in France. She earned an M.S. at Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service and a B.A. from Smith College.
