He is an expert in public international law—with specialties in international trade, investment, and environmental law—and U.S. foreign relations law. Professor Meyer has served both as counsel and an expert in cases raising international law and trade issues in U.S. courts and has testified multiple times before Congress. Prior to entering the legal academy, Professor Meyer practiced law at the Office of the Legal Adviser, U.S. Department of State and clerked for the Honorable Neil M. Gorsuch. He earned his B.A. and M.A. in history from Stanford University, and his J.D. and Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley.
