Dr. Herlevi currently serves as a Senior Research Scientist at the Center for Naval Analyses (CNA), a nonprofit research organization based in Arlington, Virginia, and as a Nonresident Fellow for the National Bureau of Asian Research (NBR), an independent research institution based in Seattle and Washington, DC. She leads research on Chinese technology acquisition and innovation, global infrastructure development, Chinese foreign policy in the Pacific Islands, and the People's Liberation Army (PLA).

Dr. Herlevi earned a PhD in international relations and comparative politics from the University of Virginia, a Master of Public Policy from George Mason University, and a Bachelor of Arts in political science and economics from North Carolina State University. She studied Mandarin at Tsinghua University (Beijing) and the Zhejiang University of Technology (Hangzhou). Dr. Herlevi has published on China's Maritime Silk Road, PLA views of Oceania, special economic zones, and the artificial intelligence ecosystem in China. She has forthcoming publications on China-Middle East relations and China's technological innovation goals. She reads and speaks Mandarin Chinese.
