Peter Mattis is the Director for Intelligence at the Special Competitive Studies Project. Prior to SCSP, he was Senior Advisor for Global Democratic Resilience at the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs (NDI) and served as the Senate-appointed staff director of the Congressional-Executive Commission on China during the 116th Congress. Peter previously worked at the Jamestown Foundation, National Bureau of Asian Research, and the Central Intelligence Agency. He graduated from the University of Washington with BAs in Political Science and Asian Studies, and from Georgetown University with an MA in Security Studies.
