

**Sameer Lalwani, External Senior Advisor, Special Competitive Studies Project; Senior Fellow,
German Marshall Fund**



Sameer Lalwani is a Senior Advisor with the Special Competitive Studies Project, a Non-Resident Senior Fellow with the German Marshall Fund, and a Research Affiliate with the MIT Security Studies Program, where he studies military and technology competition, alliances, the US-India strategic partnership, and Indo-Pacific security. He is also an Adjunct Professor at Georgetown University and a Contributing Editor to War on the Rocks. Previously, he was a Senior Expert at the US Institute of Peace where he led work sponsored by the U.S. Department of Defense on the China-India battlespace and supporting US-India defense technology cooperation, including INDUS-X. He has been the Director of the South Asia Program at the Stimson Center, an Adjunct Professor at GWU's Elliott School of International Affairs, a term member with the Council on Foreign Relations, and a Stanton Nuclear Security Postdoctoral Fellow at the RAND Corporation. He has provided expert testimony before the US House of Representatives and his work has been published in leading academic journals and analytical outlets. He holds a B.A. in Political Science from the University of California, Berkeley and a Ph.D. in Political Science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
