Henry Ziemer is an associate fellow with the Americas Program at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) in Washington, DC. His research focuses on geopolitical competition, organized crime, and defense priorities in the Western Hemisphere. His writing and analysis have been featured in *Foreign Affairs*, *Foreign Policy*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Financial Times*, and *War on the Rocks*.

Before joining CSIS, he worked as a United States researcher at the Armed Conflict Location and Event Data Project (ACLED). In addition to his work at CSIS, he is the founder of *Caballeros*, a weekly newsletter on Latin American politics and security issues. Mr. Ziemer holds a BA in global affairs and history from Yale University.
