

**Parsifal D’Sola, Founder and Executive Director,
Andrés Bello Foundation – China Latin America Research Center**



Parsifal D’Sola is founder and executive director of the Andrés Bello Foundation – China Latin America Research Center, a Bogotá-based think tank focused on China–Latin America relations. He is a foreign policy analyst specializing in China’s engagement in Latin America, with particular expertise on Venezuela. He is also a nonresident senior fellow at the Atlantic Council’s Global China Hub. In 2019, he served as an advisor on China policy to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Interim Government of Venezuela. Parsifal lived in Beijing from 2008 to 2016, where he worked as a researcher and communications manager at the news agency China Files. He holds a master’s in East Asian Studies from Columbia University, a master’s in International Politics from SOAS, University of London, and a degree in Telecommunications Engineering from the Andrés Bello Catholic University.
