Daniel J. Kritenbrink is Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary for East Asian and Pacific Affairs at the U.S. Department of State, responsible for relations with China, Mongolia, and Taiwan. Immediately prior to his current position, Mr. Kritenbrink was Director of the Office of Chinese and Mongolian Affairs. Prior to that, Mr. Kritenbrink served at the U.S. Embassy in Beijing as Chief of the Political Section's Internal Unit.

Since joining the State Department Foreign Service in 1994, Mr. Kritenbrink has served overseas in Tokyo (1994-95), Sapporo (1995-97), Kuwait (1997-99), Tokyo (2000-04), and Beijing (2005-2009). He also served as Staff Assistant to the Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern Affairs in Washington, DC (1999-2000).

Mr. Kritenbrink's foreign languages are Chinese and Japanese. He holds a B.A. from the University of Nebraska and an M.A. from the University of Virginia. He and his wife Nami have two children.
