Andrew F. Krepinevich, Jr. is a senior fellow at the Hudson Institute, an adjunct senior fellow at the Center for a New American Security, and president and CEO of Solarium LLC, a defense consulting firm. Dr. Krepinevich previously served between 1995 and 2016 as the president of the Center for Strategic and Budgetary Assessments (CSBA), which he founded in 1995, and for 21 years in the U.S. Army. He has served in the Department of Defense's Office of Net Assessment, on the personal staff of three secretaries of defense, as well as numerous task forces and policy boards. Dr. Krepinevich has testified before Congress and lectured before both professional and academic audiences.

Dr. Krepinevich has written numerous books and articles regarding deterrence, China and archipelagic defense, mostly recently authoring the 2019 monograph *The Decline of Deterrence* (Hudson Institute, 2019). Dr. Krepinevich graduated from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point and received his M.P.A. and Ph.D. from Harvard University.
