Andrew Polk is the Co-Founder of Trivium China, a China-focused macroeconomic research and business advisory firm. Mr. Polk was previously the Director of China Research at Medley Global Advisors, where he advised asset managers and hedge funds on developments in China's economy and financial markets. Mr. Polk also served as the resident China Economist at the Conference Board's China Center, where he conducted economic analysis on the Chinese economy for corporate clients and co-authored *The Long, Soft Fall in Chinese Growth*. Mr. Polk has also held research positions at the Institute of International Finance, the East Asia Desk of the U.S. Treasury Department, the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars, and *Foreign Policy* magazine. His research focus has included monetary policy, capital flows, and financial market development throughout East and Southeast Asia, with a particular emphasis on China. Mr. Polk earned his B.A. in American Studies and Communication at Texas A&M University and holds an M.A. with distinction in International Economics and China Studies from the Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS).
