



Dean G. Popps, Former Acting Assistant Secretary of the Army Acquisition, Logistics and Technology and Former Army Acquisition Executive

Dean G. Popps served two Administrations as the Acting Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology (ALT) and the Army Acquisition Executive (AAE). He served in the Department of the Army as a political appointee from 2004 to 2010. He officially retired from government in April 2010 after his successor was confirmed by the United States Senate.

As both the Acting Assistant Secretary for (ALT) and the Principal Deputy, Mr. Popps served as the Service Acquisition Executive (SAE) and had similar counterparts in Navy and Air Force. He served as the Science Advisor to the Secretary of the Army, and the Army's Senior Research and Development official. He also has principal oversight responsibility for all Department of the Army matters related to logistics.

He has been recognized for his work, notably The Joint Civilian Service Commendation Award from Ambassador L. Paul Bremer III in 2004, The Secretary of Defense's Medal for the Global War on Terrorism in 2008, the US Army Engineer Regiment's Bronze de Fleury Medal in 2008 for work in Iraq Reconstruction, the US Army's Distinguished Civilian Service Medal in 2009 for his service as the Acting Assistant Secretary of the Army and Army Acquisition Executive, and the Secretary of the Army's 4-star Leadership Award in 2010.

He currently serves as Of Counsel to the law firm of Fluet Huber+Hoang (www.fluetlaw.com) in Alexandria, VA and is a Senior Advisor to clients in the defense industry. He is Co-Chairman of the Strategic Materials Advisor Council (www.startegicmaterials.org) in Washington, DC. He is a member of the Board of Directors of both the Eutelsat America Corporation (www.eutelsatamerica.com) in Washington, DC with parent offices in Paris, France and Global Integrated Security (USA) of Reston, Virginia with parent offices in the UK (www.globalgroup-gis.com).
