Russell Hsiao is the executive director of the Global Taiwan Institute and editor-in-chief of the *Global Taiwan Brief*. He previously served as a senior research fellow at the Project 2049 Institute and national security fellow at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies in Washington DC. Prior to those positions he was the editor of *China Brief* at the Jamestown Foundation from October 2007 to July 2011 and a special assistant in the International Cooperation Department at the Taiwan Foundation for Democracy. While in law school, he clerked within the Office of the Chairman at the Federal Communications Commission and the Interagency Trade Enforcement Center at the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative. Mr. Hsiao received his J.D. and certificate from the Law and Technology Institute at the Catholic University of America's Columbus School of Law where he served as the editor-in-chief of the *Catholic University Journal of Law and Technology*.
