Mr. Hiebert is the senior adviser and deputy director of the Southeast Asia Program at the Center for Strategic and International Studies. Prior to this, he was senior director for Southeast Asia at the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, where he worked to promote trade and investment opportunities between the United States and Asia. He also worked as a journalist for the *Wall Street Journal* reporting on trade issues from Beijing and reported for the *Far Eastern Economic Review* from Kuala Lumpur and Hanoi.

Mr. Hiebert authored two books on Vietnam, *Chasing the Tigers* (Kodansha, 1996) and *Vietnam Notebook* (Review Publishing, 1993). He has also co-authored several reports on Southeast Asia, including “Southeast Asia Challenges for the Incoming Administration,” (Center for Strategic and International Studies, 2016) and “Myanmar’s New Dawn” (Center for Strategic and International Studies, 2016). Mr. Hiebert regularly publishes articles on economic and diplomatic issues in Southeast Asia.
