



Patrick J. Sinko, Associate Vice President for Research and Distinguished Professor of Pharmaceutics and Drug Delivery, Rutgers University

Dr. Sinko is a Pharmacist and a Pharmaceutical Scientist at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, where he holds the rank of Distinguished Professor (II). Dr. Sinko is also an Associate Vice President in the Office of Research and Economic Development where he leads the Office of Research Advancement. In 2015, he was appointed Distinguished Visiting Professor in the College of Chemistry at Fuzhou University. Dr. Sinko was also designated as a High-End Foreign Expert in Pharmaceutical Sciences by the China State Administration of Foreign Experts Affairs.

Dr. Sinko has served on numerous scientific advisory and review panels in China, Korea, Europe and the United States as well as on Editorial Advisory Boards for many scientific journals. He has authored or coauthored over 450 research papers, abstracts and book chapters. He is also Editor and Principal Author of *Martin's Physical Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences* (5th, 6th, and 7th editions). Dr. Sinko was elected Fellow in both the American Association for the Advancement of Science and American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists. He was also elected to serve on the Council of the AAAS and the Board of Scientific Advisors of the Controlled Release Society and was the Founding Chair of the AAPS Nanotechnology Focus Group.

Dr. Sinko is the Principal Investigator of an active research laboratory that focuses on biopharmaceutics, pharmaceutical formulations and molecular-, nano- and micro-scale drug delivery with specific applications to the treatment or prevention of HIV/AIDS, breast and lung cancer, chemical terrorism countermeasures and tuberculosis. Dr. Sinko has received the Rutgers University Board of Trustees Award for Excellence in Research and the highly selective National Institutes of Health FIRST and MERIT Awards.
