Dr. Andrew Wedeman is a Professor of Political Science at Georgia State University, where he researches China's political economy and corruption. Prior to Dr. Wedeman's appointment at Georgia State University, he spent eighteen years with the Department of Political Science at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL), where he also served as the Director of the Asian Studies Program and the Director of the UNL International Studies Program. In addition he has held posts as a visiting research professor at Beijing University, a Visiting Associate Professor of Political Science at the Johns Hopkins Nanjing University Center for Sino-American Studies, and a Fulbright Research Professorship at Taiwan National University.
