Mr. Jude Blanchette is Senior Advisor and China Practice Lead at Crumpton Group, a business advisory and geo-political risk firm based in Arlington, VA. Previously he was the engagement director at The Conference Board's China Center for Economics and Business in Beijing, where he led the Center's research on China's political environment, with a focus on the workings of the Communist Party and its impact on foreign investors.
