Chad Peltier is an analyst and consultant at Jane's, where he specializes in emerging technologies, threat assessment, forecasting, and data science. Much of his work focuses on analyzing Chinese force modernization and U.S. long-range strategic planning. His work on China has focused on topics ranging from unmanned combat aerial vehicles (UCAVs), Chinese amphibious platforms, military space and counterspace systems, and hypersonic weapons. Mr. Peltier has also given presentations to international audiences and ministries of defense on Chinese emerging technologies, with a particular focus on Chinese hypersonics, space systems, and unmanned capabilities. Before joining Jane's, he was an external research assistant for Yale University's Department of Political Science, where he conducted research on China's naval modernization. Mr. Peltier has an M.A. in International Relations from the University of Chicago.
