

David Shullman Senior Advisor, International Republican Institute

Dr. Shullman oversees IRI's work addressing the influence of China and other autocracies on democratic institutions and governance in countries around the world. He is also an Adjunct Senior Fellow at the Center for a New American Security. He previously served for nearly a dozen years as one of the U.S. Government's top experts on East Asia, most recently as Deputy National Intelligence Officer for East Asia on the National Intelligence Council. Dr. Shullman recently edited an IRI report on "China's Malign Influence and the Corrosion of Democracy." He has testified on China topics before subcommittees of both chambers of the U.S. Congress and has published in numerous outlets including Foreign Affairs and National Interest.
